95/2019	Members' Declarations Cllr Clarke declared a non-pecuniary interest in both planning items. No other declarations or dispensations declared or requested.
96/2019	Public Participation The Clerk read out two emails that had been received relating to the planning matters.
97/2019	Planning Matters Ref: PA19/06161 Proposal: Conversion of existing barn to C3, with erection of new structure to house swimming pool to rear of plot. Location: North Trevido Barn B3251 Between Lower Clicker And The B3252 At Rosemary Cottage Horningtops It was RESOLVED to support the application. Proposed Cllr Easterbrook. Seconded Cllr Pearce. Cllr Clarke abstained. All other councillors agreed. In making their decision, councillors considered recommendations from the ecological and contamination surveys and ask that planners include their advice in any determination. Additionally, councillors with local knowledge of the site are aware of ongoing issues with the water supply obtained through boreholes: they ask that planning officers consider the impact that filling and maintaining a swimming pool can have, together with the domestic requirements of up to eight additional residents.  Ref PA19/05798 Location North Treviddo Barn Horningtops Liskeard Cornwall PL14 3PS Proposal Construction of agricultural barn for purpose of hay and equipment storage. It was RESOLVED to support the application. Proposed Cllr Easterbrook. Seconded Cllr Pearce. All agreed. In making their decision, councillors considered the report from the HSE that did not advise against the proposal but did recommend consultation with the pipeline operator. Councillors with local knowledge have concerns that the current location as shown on the site plan may be less than 30m from a high pressure mains gas pipeline.
