98/2018	Apologies for Absence Received from Cllrs Medlen; Turner; Tucker; Cade; and Ball. No apologies received from Cllrs Sobey or Kendall.
99/2018	Members' Declarations Cllr Easterbrook declared an interest in Item 101/2018 Planning Application PA18/07392. However, the meeting would not have been quorate if the councillor had absented herself during discussion and voting and Cllr Easterbrook requested a dispensation to remain. Following a member discussion, the Clerk agreed to the dispensation because it was in the interests of persons living in the council's area. This complies with the council's Standing Orders 14e.
100/2018	Public Participation Mr Chris Sobey introduced his planning application PA18/07110, explained the background to the plans and how the Protected Species Licence had been granted to safeguard the colony of bats that had been discovered on the site.  Mr Michael Easterbrook attended to introduce his planning application PA18/17392 and explained that the new structure was needed in order to accommodate increased numbers of cattle being held on the farm.

It was RESOLVED to support this application. Proposed Cllr Clarke. Seconded Cllr Sneyd. All agreed. In making their decision, councillors agreed that the proposed development fits all the criteria regarding the statements outlined in the submitted Design and Access Statement, and that the plans comply with the NPPF 2012 and the Cornwall Local Plan 2010-2030.  Reference: PA18/07392 Location: South Trewint Farm Trewint Road Menheniot Liskeard Cornwall PL14 3RE Proposal: Construction of agricultural building (cattle rearing shed). It was RESOLVED to support this application. Proposed Cllr Hooper. Seconded Cllr Sneyd. All agreed. In making their decision, Councillors were aware of need for this new shed and its installation would be incorporated within the existing farm space. They are content that the appearance and design of the construction is appropriate to its setting, and that there would be no residential impact in the locality.
