Thanks for getting back to me. There are currently no charge points in Liskeard except one slow charger at Trevellis house which is an overnight charger.

I have just got an electric car via motability lease but cannot have a home charge pod installed because of a public right of way footpath across the front of the house which would mean a trip hazard if charging cables were put across it. Therefore we have to rely on public charge points.

We are given a subscription to BP Pulse and the nearest charge point is at China Fleet which is 8 miles away.

The one at Trerulefoot is Shell and is very expensive.

Therefore a charge point in the village would benefit me personally a huge amount and I would be grateful if the PC could look into it. I understand there are a number of grants available for this purpose though I am unsure what and how much, just that Motability mentioned it when I spoke to them.
