Good morning,

The Highway Technology Team are currently undertaking risk assessments to establish which highway lighting can be switched off based on specific criteria. The main areas of switch off initially will be housing estates and rural locations. Town/City centres will remain illuminated as will main roads. Implementation of part-night operation is planned for Spring 2023 and is likely to be phased as areas are risk assessed.

There is no legal requirement to conduct public consultation. Cornwall Council have consulted with key stakeholders (including emergency services) and other local authorities who already have a part-night operation system in place.

Once each area has been reviewed and is ready for switch off the Highway Technology team will meet with the Community Link Officers, Town & Parish Councils and local Police to ensure any relevant local knowledge is shared (i.e. areas with known ASB issues, high crime) as part of the decision making process.

We will be in touch further when your area is ready for switch-off
