Holy Well: **Action:** Plans being prepared to allow structure to be visible and overall improvements to the setting. The project is being developed between Cllr Cole and Jon Selman who is kindly preparing draft plans. Detailed options to be prepared and reported on at the next Public meeting. Li Selman is keeping the PCC advised of progress. The Well was last renovated in 1937 in the Coronation year of King George VI. We may be able to do similar.

Village Green. **Action.** Work is progressing well by Keith Goldsmith with the planters and potting up plants — The two planters to be placed either side of the Lych gate are nearing completion. To mark the project, a Coronation event is planned. See separate report on event. Verbal update from Keith Goldsmith.

Bus shelter **Action** Estimates are being obtained to repair and replace the beading to the glazing and a further report will be submitted with options to replace current Perspex glazing which is in places badly vandalised by attempting to set fire to the sheeting. The whole structure needs wood preservative oil to be applied to protect the timber.

Improvements to Village centre Public Realm.
Royal Mail have painted post box in village centre and others in Parish. BT have confirmed Phone box will be repainted this year.
